## 2024 INTRODUCTIONS

**BURST INTO SONG TET 17314 (sdlg x Desire of Nations) x (sdlg x All Things to All Men). 7", 32", 4-way branching (range of 2-6 way), 16 buds (range of 10-24), ML, Sev, Minnesota instant rebloom ranges from 33%-70% depending on the year. Good early morning opener (EMO) and cold morning opener (CMO). Every once in a while a bloom isn't perfect. Dark purple cranberry, icy light lavender eye, icy light lavender plus ivory edge with some teeth, chartreuse throat. Fertile both ways. It has always been an "outside" plant so I've only seen one seedling out of it so far, but lots should bloom in 2024.....\$150DF**

**DOMAIN OF DARKNESS TET 31214 (Soli Deo Gloria x sdlg) x sdlg. 6", 24" (range of 20-25"), 4-way branching, ML, 15 buds (range of 10-21), Sev (but about 80% dormant and not happy in the greenhouse which doesn't go below freezing), some instant rebloom in Minnesota, good cold morning opener (CMO). Dark merlot wine, light lavender eye on some days and almost black on others (see website), light lavender plus white edge, short white midribs, green throat. An impressive clump covered in blooms. It looks like this every day – this color, this substance, no spotting, no melting in the sun. Its heavy substance holds up to rain and sun and heat. What's not to like? It's not as tall as I would like, but it's always above the foliage. More importantly, it's not self-cleaning – which means that the blooms from the day before don't quickly dry up and drop off. They are a gloppy mess as can be seen in the last 2 pictures on the website, and the plant needs to be deadheaded to look its best. Many people won't care because of its beauty, but don't order it if you see deadheading on a large clump to be a chore. Fertile both ways but I won't see any of its kids until 2024 because it has always been grown outside and I rarely hybridize there. Note that Soli Deo Gloria genes tend to breed very dark kids that don't slick or melt.....\$150DF**

**GREAT IS THY FAITHFULNESS TET 32118 (sdlg x Pray Without Ceasing) x Written in Stone. 6", 26", 4-way branching (range of 3-5), 16 buds (range of 10-20), M, Sev, Re (but not outside in Minnesota). Blend of magenta, dark lavender and pink; icy indented lavender watermark; icy lavender plus yellow ivory edge with ruffles and some teeth; yellow to green throat. A good increaser. Fertile both ways, but always an outside plant so I won't see its offspring until 2024.....\$125DF**

**HEAD FOR THE HILLS TET 32518 (Hidden in My Heart x Flying Purple People Eater). 7", 32" (40" one year), 4-way branching (range of 3-7), 24 buds (range of 13-56), M, Dor (Dor in GH but more Sev outside), Re (but not outside in MN). As you can see, there are large variations in average budcount and branching and height – it depends on the weather and crowding. It makes a beautiful clump with lots of bloom and lovely foliage. Medium cranberry that can vary with temperature, grape plus lavender feathery eye, small lavender edge, small white midribs extending about 1/3 of the way up the petals, green throat. Not pod fertile for me (like its pollen parent). The pollen looks good but I haven't used it since I've been intent on setting pods on it to get its plant habit in more of my seedlings.....\$85DF**

**I STAND AMAZED TET 12417 {Mystery of the Ages x (sdlg x Irreconcilable Differences)} x {Broken Chains x sdlg}. 6", 30" (27-33" depending on location), 3-way branching (range of 2-4), 15 buds (range of 8-16 and less in drought; note that budcount was not higher in the greenhouse this past year than outside, so unlike most of mine it might not increase in budcount going south), ML, Sev, Re (some to lots of instant rebloom outside in MN), EMO, CMO, and holds up in hard rain. Stunningly beautiful. Saturated color that only rarely shows spots. Grape with gray lavender eye, gray lavender edge plus yellow ivory teeth, white midribs on half of the petal, green throat. Fertile both ways and some really beautiful offspring (see website for kids and grandkids). I've barely scratched the surface of what it can do as a parent and grandparent since it has lived most of its life outside being testing in a couple of locations...\$225DF**

**LIAR LIAR PANTS ON FIRE TET 16316 (Irreconcilable Differences x sdlg) x Scarlet Pimpernel. 8" (sometimes 7.5" if it recurves a lot), 32" (range of 28-34"), 3-way branching (range of 2-6 depending on scape and location), 15 buds (range of 7-22 depending on scape and location), Sev in the greenhouse so that is how I registered it to be conservative but it's mostly dormant outside, ML, EMO, CMO, some instant rebloom outside in Minnesota (and lots in the greenhouse). Dark rose red with pinkish red eye, small pinkish red edge plus white teeth, white midribs, green throat. Eye-catching flower that stands out across the garden. Although the scape is top-branched, the flowers bloom one at a time and don't get gloppy or interfere with each other. The flowers also make up their own mind as to which direction they will face when they bloom – sometimes to the sky, sometimes left or right or looking down. Fertile both ways. See website for pics of kids and grandkids.....\$150DF**

**FOUNTAIN OF TEARS TET 9115 (Inspired By Hope x Sword of Justice) x (sdlg x Inspired By Hope). 7", 28", 4-way (range of 2-4 outside depending on location and 5 in the greenhouse), 15 buds (15-17 Kentucky, 10 California, 25 in GH), Sev, EM, Re. Dusky lavender pink, multi lavender eye with ivory pattern, lavender plus ivory edge, chartreuse throat. Fertile both ways with lots of interesting/awesome offspring (see website), many of which are hardy in Minnesota. Now here's the hard part and part of the reason for its name. It is NOT hardy in Minnesota and some of the plants tested in a very tough location in Louisiana with chaotic weather rotted (but the kids were fine and Fountain of Tears showed much higher than average resistance to rust). It performed well in Kentucky in terms of hardiness and increase and plant habit. In its California test location it could have used more cold weather to increase branching and budcount. It has beautiful days in each of its test locations, but it also has many days when it doesn't pattern or has poorly-formed blooms (hence the tears). As a result, this one is FOR HYBRIDIZERS ONLY AND FOR PERSONAL USE ONLY, WHICH MEANS YOU MUST AGREE TO NO RESELLING OR GIFTING OR TRADING (although it's OK to sell seeds from it). In addition, there is NO ONE-YEAR REPLACEMENT/REFUND GUARANTEE ON IT EXCEPT IN A CLIMATE ZONE WITH SIMILAR CONDITIONS TO PINOLE, CALIFORNIA AND BOWLING GREEN, KENTUCKY. Although you will order and interact with me, ALL PLANTS OF FOUNTAIN OF TEARS WILL BE SENT DIRECTLY FROM SUBHANA ANSARI IN CALIFORNIA. (When I needed to empty the greenhouse for a year in the summer of 2021, she graciously agreed to take the Fountain of Tears plants since they aren't hardy here.) The price includes the separate shipping cost.....\$165DF**

**SALES INFORMATION:** Each order is important, and I personally choose and box each plant. Plants are state-inspected. Shipping is by priority mail in May and June (plus I can do September shipping to the south). \$15 for the first plant and \$3 for each additional plant. A check or money order should be made payable to Springwood Gardens. U.S shipments only. Prices are for a double fan or more. I ship large plants, although sometimes the size is weather or cultivar dependent. I promise you will be very happy with the size of your order as a whole☺ All Springwood introductions have been grown and tested outside before selection. They are not babied or given special care. They are planted on top of a cold, windswept hill with almost no snow cover. The ground around the daylilies is covered with a couple of inches of hardwood bark for weed control. They are given at least an inch of water a week during the growing season and only rarely any fertilizer. During bloom season, nights are typically in the 60's and days in the 80's and 90's, but in making evaluations, I also watch how the flowers open when temps are in the 50's. Most of the dormants are lined out outside. The semi-evergreens are lined out in the greenhouse (where they are grown in the ground in raised beds, receiving only regular fertilizer and water and sprayed for insects as needed), enabling you to receive large, high quality, blooming size plants when it's most convenient for you in the spring. I recognize that not everyone is enamored of plants grown in greenhouses, but in our climate it's often the only way I'm able to ship before early June! Bloom occurs in April and May in the greenhouse, and it is likely you will receive a plant that has already scaped (happy to send scapes for pollen if I have them). Most buyers report first year bloom (and often rebloom) on the majority of the plants that I send, although not usually in sync with their peak bloom time. Northerners will find that their plants will re-establish more quickly if they request delivery after the soil has warmed up in their area and after hard frosts are expected. I guarantee my plants for a year – see above or the order form for specifics.

**GUARANTEE:** Springwood Gardens' introductions are guaranteed for a year in zone 4 and higher if: they are planted well before fall frost and grown in normal garden conditions (e.g. grown in the ground rather than in pots, not in standing water, watered as needed, soil not overly compacted); bark or other mulch is put around the plants to keep the roots cool and moist (no extra winter mulching needed); plants are not divided when first received or during the first year. (Note: it's best to avoid dividing or transplanting daylilies when they are stressed by high temps or drought, and northerners report better success dividing daylilies in spring or early summer, rather than in the fall.)

**CLUB PRICING:** Clubs will receive at least twice catalogue value if the plants are my choice based on availability, but they will come from your long wish list.

**GIFT PLANTS:** Rather than sending gift plants, my practice has been to keep prices reasonable, send large plants, and send extra fans (if available) on larger orders since that is what most people seem to prefer.

**VISITORS:** Peak bloom outside is usually mid-July through mid-August. Visitors are welcome by appointment, and I'm happy to do formal tours for groups of 10 or more.
